- 8. **School Uniform** A reminder <u>that only blazers must be worn indoors</u>, outdoor jackets/hooded tops etc should be removed as soon as pupils enter the building, in class <u>and</u> when moving between classes. Pupils wearing outdoor jackets or non-school uniform items will have them confiscated if they persist in wearing them in school. **Mr McGhee**
