PUPIL UPDATES: Please read to ALL classes during P1.

- 3. **School Uniform** A reminder <u>that only blazers must be worn indoors</u>, outdoor jackets/hooded tops etc should be removed as soon as pupils enter the building, in class <u>and</u> when moving between classes. Pupils wearing outdoor jackets or non-school uniform items will have them confiscated if they persist in wearing them in school. **Mr McGhee**
- 4. Pupil must remain within the Fuel Zone/Assembly Hall or school grounds at interval and lunchtimes unless they have been issued with pass to attend a club by a teacher. Please wait for the bell to make your way up to classes. Mr McGhee
- 5. Pupil Support/Wellbeing Corridor pupils must not enter this corridor at interval or lunchtime unless they have an appointment with their Pupil Support Teacher or have permission to attend the Wellbeing Hub/Room 60. Mr McGhee
- 6. Pupils out of class pupils must not leave class before the bell, or be out of class during lessons without a valid reason, <u>a corridor pass must be issued by your teacher</u>. Mr McGhee
- 7. Mobile phones/Headphones these must not be visible in class. They will be confiscated and held in the school office if pupils persist in using them. Mr McGhee
