## **Pathway Apprenticeship**

- Need to leave school to do this and offered in lots of different sectors such as Healthcare, IT and Social Services.
- What is involved: It's delivered by learning providers, in partnership with employers

You'll gain knowledge, skills and experience through a series of practical activities including industry projects and work placements

The apprenticeship lasts up to 26 weeks (36 weeks for engineering) and can be extended up to 52 weeks if you are care experienced or disabled

You'll get a £100 weekly allowance
